

August 23rd and August 26th Alignment Hearing Committee Votes

1. Dan Hornick moved, Elie Bracy seconded and the committee voted 4-0 to approve George Wythe's appeal to move down to Class 1, Region C instead of their assigned alignment to Class 2, Region C.

Rationale: Based on changes or corrections in your school's March 31st ADM numbers.

2. Dan Hornick moved, Elie Bracy seconded and the committee voted 5-0 to deny Grayson Co.'s appeal to move down to Class 1, Region C instead of their assigned alignment to Class 2, Region C.

Rationale: Based on not meeting criteria to consider being moved to a lower classification.

3. Dan Hornick moved, Elie Bracy seconded and the committee voted 4-0 to approve Monticello's appeal to move down to Class 3, Region C instead of their assigned alignment to Class 4, Region D.

Rationale: Based on changes or corrections in your school's ADM figures.

12. Dave Melton moved, Dan Hornick seconded and the committee voted 4-1 (Melton voting not) to approve Sherando's appeal to move down to Class 4, Region D instead of their assigned alignment to Class 5, Region D.

Rationale: Based on misrepresentation of ADM numbers.

13. Dan Hornick moved, Elie Bracy seconded and the committee voted 5-0 to deny Freedom - LC's appeal to move down to Class 5, Region D instead of their assigned alignment to Class 6, Region B.

Rationale: Based on not meeting criteria to move to a lower classification.

14. Dan Hornick moved and Elie Bracy seconded and the committee voted 4-0 to approve Loudoun County Public Schools' appeal with the adjustment of Freedom to the Cedar Run District based on not receiving a waiver to play down and to form an additional district within their school division in Class 4 and due to the alignment assignments move affected schools to the appropriate districts for Class 4 and Class 5 schools.

Rationale: Adjustment of Freedom High School to the Cedar Run District based on not receiving a waiver to play down and place schools in proper districts based on classification and form a new district for their Class 4 schools.
